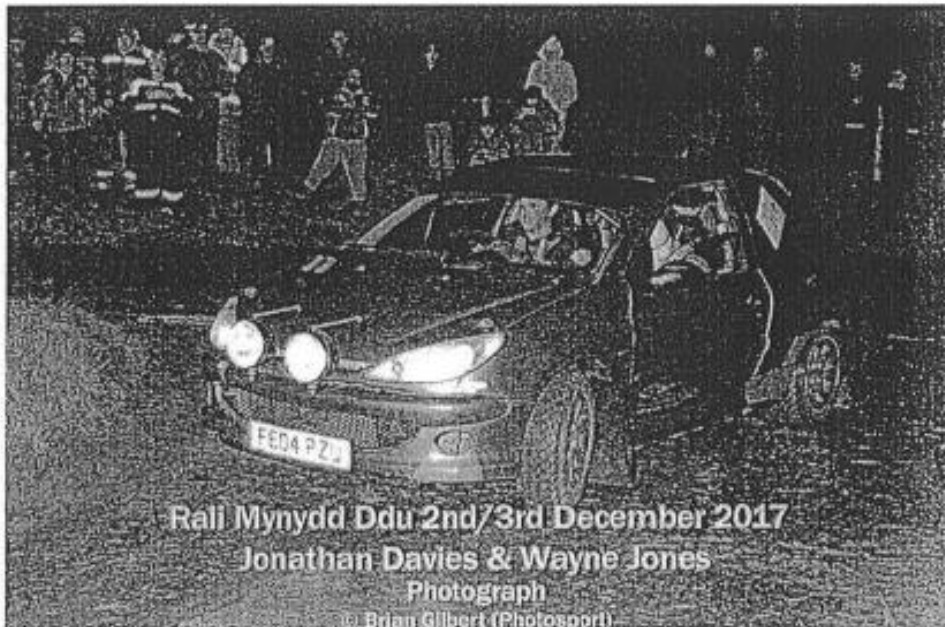

Final instructions

Your rally number is per the seeded entry list which can be seen here:

Your start time will be 21.53 + your car number

- **Officials**

Delete Dylan Jenkins add Dorian Evans.

- **Fuel**

Fuel will be available up until 11pm at Tesco petrol station, Pontardawe SA8 3AZ.

- **Trailers**

There is no official trailer park, trailers will not be permitted into the rally car park or scrutineering venue.

Noise

- Noise will open at 17.00 hrs and close at 20.30 hrs, noise test will be 86db at 2metres, Noise will be next to slice and dice in Alloy industrial estate Swansea SA8 4EZ - see picture.

- **Scrutiny**

Scrutiny will open at 17.00 hrs and close at 20.30 hrs, scrutineering will be at A&M garage Alloy industrial estate Pontardawe Swansea SA84EN see picture, after noise please go to the end of the road around the roundabout and queue on the left.

All competitors must produce a V5 registration document, mot certificate where applicable and proof of road fund licence for the vehicle entered in.

- **Car park**

On completion of noise check and scrutineering, proceed back to the roundabout where you came in and take the 4th exit onto the A474. At the next roundabout take the first exit towards Lidl and follow the road down to the end where you will be guided into the car park.

- **Signing on**

Make your way on foot to Pontardawe RFC, signing on will open at 17.00 hrs and close at 20.30 hrs. All outstanding monies will be cash only. After signing on competitors will receive a rally pack containing rally plates, timecards and other relevant information.

- **Insurance**

Anyone not complying with MARSH drivers declaration will need to get in touch with Marsh ASAP. You will not be able to apply for a cover letter on the night.

- **Licenses**

All competitor who are not already in possession of a RS clubman license need to apply for one before the event.

- **Maps**

All competitors will need the latest edition of Ordnance Survey map 160 (1:50,000 series latest edition) there will be a handout of map 159 & 170 which will be printed under license number AC0000857996.

- **Marshals**

Please be aware that the stipulation of **no Marshal no start** will be strictly enforced, all competitors must sign on a Marshal. Marshals will be expected to wear a high vis tabard which will be available at Marshals signing on. **Please remind Marshals not to litter.** Please make your Marshal aware of their requirement to open their control on time or risk exclusion of their crew.

- **Damage**

All competitors are reminded that it is their duty to report any damage caused to third party property, no matter how insignificant they feel this might be, this can be detailed on the damage declaration form at the bottom of timecard 2 and handed into MC3. Competitors that have been involved in an accident should act as noted in section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 which will be in your pack.

- **Results**

In the event of a tie, they will be decided of furthest cleanest then if still not resolved, in favour of smallest engine capacity as per rule R15.2.2

Amendments to SR's

15. CONTROLS

Delete: SS – Standard Section Start Time Control.

SF – Standard Section Finish Time Control.

16. TIMING

STANDARD SECTION

Delete: Timing at any time control on such sections will be when the competitor has passed the control board, NOT when the timecard is presented to the marshal.

Insert: Timing at Time Controls will be when the Time Control Card is presented to the marshal and NOT the time of entering the control area as per R12.3.

R12.6.1 (3/4 Rule) may NOT be applied on Standard Sections.

Some Standard Sections will be timed to an accuracy of less than one minute as per R12.8

Where a control at the end of a section timed to the second also forms the start of a section timed to the minute, the departure will be taken as the time of arrival but to the preceding whole minute (i.e., the seconds will be ignored). This will be in accordance with R 12.5.2.

NEUTRAL SECTION

Delete: Competitors may be instructed to reduce lateness en route

Where a control at the end of a section timed to the second also forms the start of a section timed to the minute, the departure will be taken as the time of arrival but to the preceding whole minute (i.e., the seconds will be ignored). This will be in accordance with R 12.5.2.

Insert: R12.6.1 (3/4 Rule) may NOT be applied on Neutral Sections. • Timing at Time Controls will be when the Time Control Card is presented to the marshal and NOT the time of entering the control area as per R12.3.

TRANSPORT SECTION

Insert: R12.6.1 (3/4 Rule) may be applied if applicable.

20. DRIVING STANDARDS OBSERVERS

Delete: DSO's may be appointed by the organisers in accordance with G11.1 – 11.2.3 and R8.2 – 8.5.2. Failure to stop when requested by a DSO will incur the penalty of EXCLUSION. Details of DSO's will be displayed at Documentation. Also, DSO's will sign the competitors DSO Card in the appropriate place

Insert: The WAMC appointed DSO will be in attendance throughout the event. The organisers will also appoint Driving Standards Observers (DSOs), who will also be Judges of Fact, to adjudicate on facts as listed under R8.1 and R8.3. A check manned by a DSO will be identified by a control board with DSO displayed on it only. Failure to stop when requested by a DSO will incur the penalty of DISQUALIFICATION. A full list of DSOs will be displayed at documentation.

D8.1.4 it will be the competitor's responsibility to note any information displayed at the start
