Final Instructions

Your start number is as per seeded entry list - MCO times will be displayed on notice board.

Seeded entry list will be on display at MCO.

There is NO on the day event insurance available, please make sure you arrange your own cover to be compliant with the road traffic act.

ALL competitors must complete RS Interclub license (minimum) for the Interclub event, and Clubman's License (minimum) for the clubman event prior to the event online sign on deadline.

Reminder – Only "E" Marked tyres will be permitted to be used – please refer to the MSUK National Competition Rules.

The route will be approx 28 miles total.

RallyAppLive App

This year the event will be using the RallyAppLive app. All competitors will need to be running a smartphone with GPS capabilities in which the RallyAppLive app will need to be installed. All competitors must also ensure that both the drivers and navigators contact numbers are correct on their entry.

The app is completely free and can be downloaded from both the Android Playstore and the Iphone Appstore and has the below Icon. Also links below to its respective page on both appstores:

All competitors must ensure they have charging facilities to keep their phone charged throughout the day as the app will be required from the start of the first test to the end of the last test. Organisers and officials are not responsible for phones running out of battery during the day.

Circuit Rulings

All competitors are required to place a **ground sheet / environmental** to place under their car if work or refuel is required while parked at Pembrey Circuit. A **spill kit** is also required to be carried.

These are mandatory requirements to help protect the venue and maintain good environmental standards. Please make sure you have one with you on the day — no exceptions.

Vehicles may remain at the circuit overnight between Saturday and Sunday, but no overnight stay by any person is allowed!

Competitors are also allowed a single service vehicle and a gazebo setup for the day.

**Any competitor broken down on a test will be recovered and/or towed when safe to do so.
This means that you may not be recovered immediately at the end of the test you are on.**

All the above rulings will be strictly enforced throughout the day. Any breaches may lead to exclusion.

Awards / Prizes

Trophies will be issued to 1st, 2nd 3rd of each class along with trophies for highest placed 1400cc, mixed crew, 4WD, and highest Clubman class.

There will also be a cash prize of £500 to 1st place Overall, and £100 awarded to the 1st placed winners of the Expert, Semi-Expert and Novice class.

Trailer Park

All trailers are to be parked in the trailer park marked on the map at the bottom, completely at your own risk!

What3Words: ///stop.either.shredding

Under no circumstances are cars to be offloaded at the noise or scrutineering venues, ALL cars must be offloaded in the trailer park grounds and driven to noise and scrutineering!

Noise Test

Noise test will be held at the location marked on the map at the bottom – Opens at 15:00 on Saturday, closes at 18:00. Sunday it opens at 06:00 and closes at 08:00, remember booking only for Sunday! Noise test will be in line with 2025 Motorsport UK NCR's.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be held at the location marked on the map at the bottom – Opens at 15:00 on Saturday, closes at 18:00. Sunday it opens at 06:00 and closes at 08:05, remember booking only for Sunday! Please make sure your vehicle is ready to present along with your documents such as MOT, Logbook etc.

Competitor's Car Park/Rally Pack Collection

All cars are to be parked at the location marked on the map below, please park as instructed by the marshals and proceed to the administration office, marked on the map at the bottom, to sign on which opens at 06:10 and closes at 08:40

Drivers Briefing

Will be held outside MCO and take place at 08:20 at the podium outside the scrutineering bay or inside if raining – **All crews MUST attend, and spot checks will be undertaken.**

Seeding

No discussion will be had regarding seeding and a penalty, at the discretion of the Clerk of the course, may be applied for any breaches.

Marshal's

Opens at 15:00 and closes at 18:00 on Saturday and Sunday opens at 06:00 and closes at 08:05.

Marshal signing-on will be held at the Formula Bar marked on the map at the bottom.

What3Words: ///functions.measure.overlooks

All marshals must be signed on prior to any crews being handed their drivers pack. All marshals must be signed on by 08:05.

Any marshal not pre-booked may result in the competing crew not being allowed to start which will result in no refund of entry fee.

The deadline for booking controls is 9pm Friday 27th February 2026 and if not pre-booked, then competitors will incur a fee of £10 to assign a control on the day.

Please make sure the chief marshal signs your process card which you will then return to the competitor for them to gain their drivers pack.

No marshal No start!

All marshals should equip themselves appropriately and must wear a hi-viz coat / vest, if you do need a hi-viz please ask!

We ask ALL marshals to download What3Words App to make finding their control location easy.

We recommend all marshals are accompanied.

Competitors documents / signing on

Please make sure all competitors bring all the relevant documents on the morning of the event:

- Eligible Club Cards
- Competitors Competition Licenses
- Insurance Policies

All competitors will be required to sign on online via their entry made through Rallyresults.co.uk and we ask that competitors upload required documents to their entry.

Any crews who are not signed on by 8pm, 27th February 2026 and wish to sign on in person, on the morning of the event, will incur a £15 fee.

Any crew refusing to pay the £15 may not be allowed to start.

Online signing on will be available from the evening of the 22nd February 2026.

Any payments being made on the morning will only be accepted in cash!

Regulations Amendments:

Marshals – Remove:

Important: As a condition of entry, each crew must provide a marshal (crews names will be pulled from a hat who would need to provide a marshal)

Marshals – Add:

Important: As a condition of entry, each crew must provide a marshal.

Scrutineering – Remove

No radio transmitting devices may be fitted. Competitors may carry mobile phones, but they must be **SWITCHED OFF** for the duration of the event and must ONLY be used in the event of an emergency i.e. to summon help after retiring from the event and / or to contact any of the emergency services should the need arise.

Scrutineering – Add

Competitors may carry a mobile phone, but must only be used for the purpose of using the RallyAppLive app which is required for the duration of the event, and / or in an emergency.

Penalties – Remove:

Using a mobile phone or any other Radio Transmitting Device, other than in an emergency, contact assistance after a breakdown or off	Disqualification

Penalties – Add:

Any competitor not using a ground or environmental sheet when performing repairs or servicing	Disqualification
Leaving a Passage Control Early or not stopping at all within the designated box before the 5 second countdown has ended on a passage control on the RallyAppLive app, and the app has not switched to continue	1 minute
