Schedule

- 9:00am - Cars arrive, tour pack collection and breakfast (ensure you arrive at least 1 hour before your start time)
- 9:00am - 10:30am QC Cars Showroom open
- 10:31am – Car 1 departs from QC Car Park
- 10:51 – Car 21 departs from Highwayman Car park
- 11:35am – last car departs
- 2:30pm – first car back (note: this is an approximate time – no timings on event)
- 2:30pm – Afternoon food available (will not be available before this, so enjoy the route and rest stops – no need to rush!)
- 3:35pm – last car due back
- 4:30pm – All cars to be moved from QC car park – gates locked! – see below



Arrival

- Please arrive from 9:00 am. Follow any instructions by the marshals to help park.
- The diagram on Page 6 shows a map of the start venue. For parking we are using both the Highwayman car park and QC cars next door.
 - Cars 1-20 park in the premises at QC
 - Cars 21-65 park in the Highwayman car park (double parking may be necessary)
- Please collect your Tour Pack from Sasha and Stuart (either inside the bar area of the pub or in the car park – weather dependant)
- In the morning and afternoon we have use of the bar area in the pub. On entering the pub, turn right and right again around the bar.

Start Procedure

Cars have been assigned a start number and start time (see Seeded Entry List with Start times and Parking Locations on Page 5).

- Cars will leave at 1 minute intervals in number order – a marshal will set you off.
- The start is at the exit to the car park (either QC or the Highwayman).
- Please don't arrive at the start control more than 5 minutes before your start time.
- Rally plates are numbered and you have an entry list, so please check to see who you are following.

Return procedure

On your return, please park in the same car park that you were assigned at the start of the event.

- For those parking in the Highwayman car park – please park considerately – we do not have exclusive use of the car park
- For those parking in QC – please vacate the car park by 4:30pm so that the gates can be locked. Please move to the Highwayman car park if necessary.

Tour Pack

In your tour pack you will receive:

- Souvenir Rally Plate to attach to the front of your car
- Cable ties to tie on rally plate
- Road book
- Seeded entry list with times
- Club membership cards (if requested)
- Quiz sheet
- Info sheet about Matlock Motor Club
- Pen
- Food tickets for you to exchange inside the pub for your selected food choices
- Club merchandise order form



Route

- Note that it is an **anticlockwise** route.
- From the OS maps link, you can download a GPX file – you can use this if your satnav accepts it.
- Note that the route leaves OS map 119 and onto OS map 110 for about half a mile.

A list of potential rest stops has been included with distances and approximate timings from the start so that you can plan your breaks and make reservations if desired (page 7). We have included pubs, picnic areas, car parks, laybys and public toilets. Note that charges will apply for some of the parking areas. Most car parks in Derbyshire can be paid for via phone. See details and links on the list.

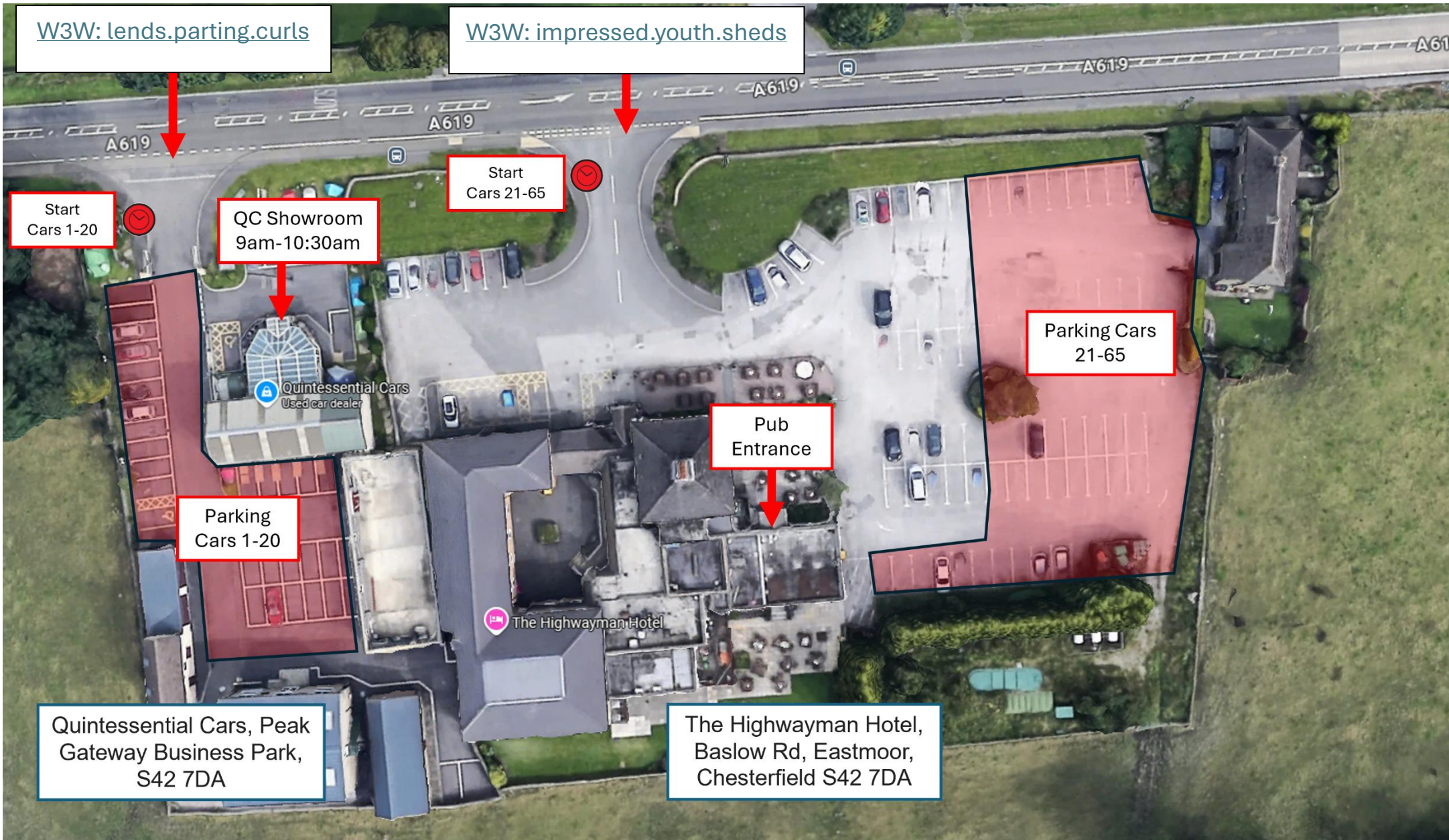
