The site speed limit is 10mph, please respect this. Space in the holding area is limited, please only bring your competition car and one other vehicle and park sensibly. We do have catering in attendance please try and support them throughout the day.

Please remember this is **non-spectator event**, at the request of the land owner. Any persons found on the tests, associated with a crew may cause the crews exclusion.

### **[4]Eligibility**

**Reminder** – NCR13.11C.4.1. The organisers understand that due the nature of the surface (Airfield Concrete) that tyre wear maybe be a concern, therefore a maximum of 8 tyres per competing car will be allowed, which must be as per Motorsport UK Targa Road Rally regulations.

**[11]Identification**

**Reminder** – Competitors will be identified by numbered rally plates, these must be affixed, one on the bonnet, and one on the rear window/boot, orange numbers must be displayed on both rear side windows or on the rear quarter panel. These will be provided by the organisers at signing on all numbers must be removed before driving on a public road.

**[12]Entries**

**Reminder** – The Gates will open at 14:00 and close at 20:00 on the Saturday, and open at 05:30 and close at ~~07:30~~ 07:15 on the Sunday.

**[15]Officials**

**Add** – Club Stewards

**[16]Timing/Controls**

**Add** – Tests 1&2, 4&5 6&7 and 7&8 will start at 30 second intervals. Tests 3&4 will start at 1-minute intervals, this has been requested, by Motorsport UK, and will be monitored throughout the day and may still be subject to change.

Competitors may be requested to make up time to enable the event to stay on schedule.

**[18]Servicing**

**Add** – Please bring a suitable ground sheet and use it when working on your vehicle. Refuelling must be carried out from approved containers, preferably by pump, in the designated area, see site plan, failure to adhere is exclusion. The service/holding area has limited space, only one additional vehicle will be admitted with your competition car, please park trailers and additional vehicles as per the site plan.

**[21]Marshals**

**Reminder** – We still need more marshals, please ask a friend/relative to come along. Without the generous support of the marshals, we would not have an event. Whilst we are not insisting that each competitor brings a marshal it would be an enormous help if you could ask your friends and club colleagues if they could support our event.
