

## 3<sup>RD</sup> RALLYE EAST YORKSHIRE- FINAL INSTRUCTIONS – 28<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2023

As a young club we appreciate having received your entry for the third running of this Historic & Targa Road Rally.

We would like to emphasise that these instructions form an integral part of the written instructions to competitors. As such they should be treated as part of the regulations of the event as should Notices and Amendments posted on the Official Notice Board to be found at Rally HQ.

Having completed the seeding of competitors you will find your START number on the attached seeded entry list and your due time at MTC 1 will be 09.00 PLUS your start number in minutes.

The Rally will start on Sunday 4th June from the Stables Paddock of Sledmere House Entrance to the Paddock is from the Kirby Grindalythe road [Grid ref: Map 101 - 927/648] or What3Words [blackmail.tangent.contents](https://www.what3words.com/blackmail.tangent.contents)

The rally HQ will be at the Eastern end of the Paddock[930/648] What3Words [avocado.surpassed.sofas](https://www.what3words.com/avocado.surpassed.sofas)

Noise and Scrutineering checks will take place in the Barn Yard and is accessed from the Stables Paddock by following the signage. When completed turn RIGHT out of the Barn Yard onto the Main village road and after 150M turn right at the Wagoners Memorial and return to the Paddock

Random Scrutineering checks will take place throughout the event at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer. Anyone not complying to a request from any Scrutineer may be subject to Exclusion at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

### Amendments to Supplementary Regulations.

SR 8 & 9 - In response to the number of entries in each of the available classes we will be merging some classes set out in SR 8 and consequently this will be reflected in the Awards presented. Thus the full range of Awards listed in SR 9 may not be available. Awards available are listed on the Rally HQ Notice Board..

SR 11 - A full and up to date list of Officials will be included in the Roadbook and posted on the Virtual Notice Board found on the club website at [WWW.yorkshirewoldsmotorclub.co.uk](http://WWW.yorkshirewoldsmotorclub.co.uk).

SR 16 - A reminder that Mobile telephones are not permitted except in case of emergency, all crew members should familiarise themselves with R 7.2.3 of the "Blue Book". Inappropriate use of a mobile phone for any purpose except an emergency may result in "Exclusion" from the event.

The first car should be due at the finish of Leg 1 at 12.00 on Sunday and at the finish of Leg 2 at approx 16.30 on Sunday

Remember every car must be fitted with its full manufacturers TRIM [R18.1.4] vehicles not adhering to this regulation may be issued with a non-compliance and be subject to penalties or exclusion at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Reg 15.1 To be classified as a finisher, a competitor MUST report to all Main Time Controls and, unless otherwise stated in the SR's at least two-thirds of the controls listed in the Route Card/Time Card.

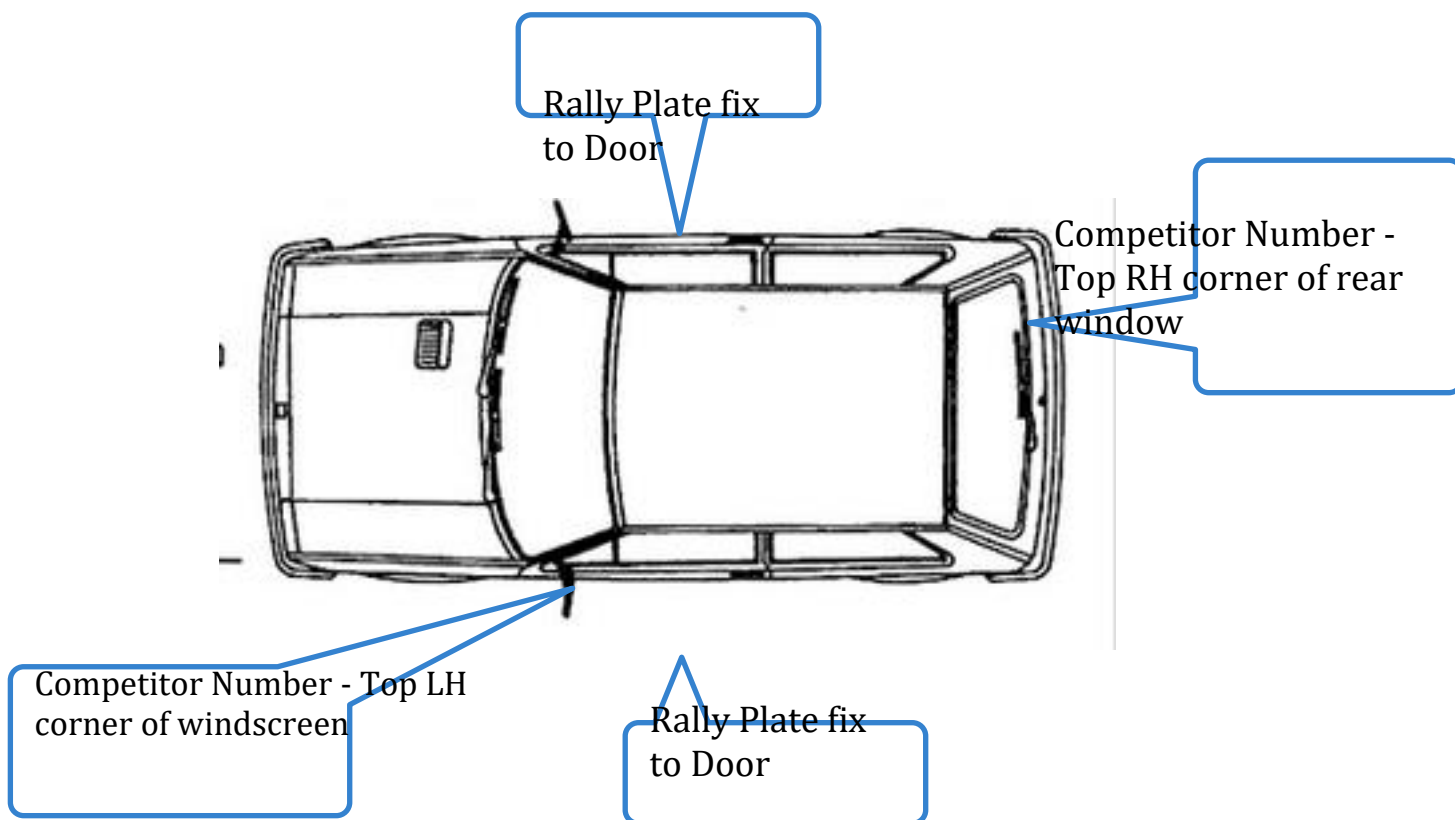
Competitors are reminded that they must carry a small spill kit, First Aid Kit, Warning Triangle and OK/SOS Board. You MUST present a valid MOT certificate or V112 declaration at Scrutineering irrespective of the vehicle age.

All injuries and incidents on the public highway must be reported to the Police authority as detailed in section 170 Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 Highway Code.

Any Incident/Injury occurring on a Test MUST be reported to the Competitor Liaison/Clerk of the Course.
